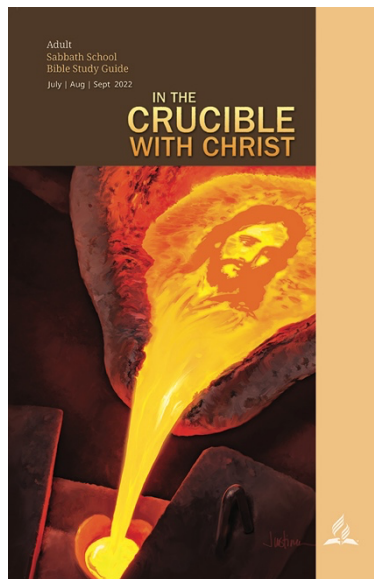

WALKING – A regular brisk walk was associated with low risks for heart disease, cancer and early death, according to a study of 78,500 British adults, with findings showing that for every 2,000 steps up to about 10,000 logged daily, the risk of early death drops by 8% to 11%. Logging 9,800 steps a day reduced dementia risk by 40%, the findings published in JAMA Internal Medicine showed, and walking at a brisk pace of about 80 steps per minute brought the greatest benefits.
